REGISTRATION DESK

The Registration Desk will be situated in the building of the Israel Film Archive/Jerusalem Cinematheque. It will be open on Tuesday, April 16 from 16:00 - 22:00 hrs and on Wednesday - Friday, April 17 - 19 during session hours.

USEFUL INFORMATION

The weather in April is usually warm and sunny, with average temperatures ranging from 22° C (70° F) during the day to 10° C (50° F) at night. We recommend that you bring jackets for the cooler evenings. Rain is possible. Dress is informal. If you are planning to tour please bring swimsuits, head covering and walking shoes. The electric current in Israel is 220 volts. Travel Medical insurance is recommended.

TRANSPORTATION FROM THE AIRPORT TO JERUSALEM

Ben Gurion International Airport (Tel Aviv Airport) is situated 45 kilometers from Jerusalem. The following means of transport are available:

"Sherut" - a shared taxi - provided by the Nesher Company. This service is available from the airport at all hours and will bring you to your destination. Price: approximately \$10 per person.

Private taxis: available outside the arrival hall. Price: approximately \$35 per cab (max. 4 persons).
