

NEWS FROM THE DOCUMENTATION COMMISSION

The FIAF Classification Scheme for Literature on Film and Television by Michael Moulds has now been published by Aslib in London. It is the product of many years work in conjunction with the FIAF Documentation Commission.

The scheme is specifically designed for use in the documentation collections of member archives and has been kept as simple as its comprehensive and detailed coverage allows. It is already in use in the Nederlands Filmmuseum, the Australian Film Institute, Filmoteca Nacional de Espana and the television collection of the Danske Filmmuseum.

The introduction gives helpful advice to beginning classifiers and the volume includes a subject index and a selection of practical examples of the use of the scheme.
