 foundation of the FIAF, which works with its exeoutive committee in close association。
2.) The task of the Federation Internationale p.1.Recherche Cinénatographique is the entire science of cinematography, according to its division into regional groups with preference of historic themes within these groups.
3.) In order to fulfill the tasks nomed in 2, regional research groups axe to be formed in the countries united in the FIAF, the extent and the orgenisation of which is left to these countries. In relation to the central executive of the Féderation Internationele \$.1. Récherche Cinómatographique they represent a juridic person and notify the central executive of theirs permanent responsible representative (presidont) as woll as of his substitute. It is obligatory to join' the central Federation Internationale p.l. rócherche Cinématographique.
4.) Beyond this the central executive has the right to nominate distinguished individual persons and other research associations as corresponding members and to invite them to the congresses. Besearoh works subinitted by these can 2 sso be accepted for the publications of the Fédration Internstionale p.1. Rëcherche Cinématographique (see 7,8). It is also possible to aotively seek membership of the F'doration if two members of the central executive support this application and the rest agree to it.
5.) The central executive of the Féderation p.1. Ritherche Cincmatographique consists of the President, .....Vicepresidents and .....members of the exreus tive conititee, who are deternined by election, further three general secretaries one of whom pexiorms the schera functions of an administrative seoretary.
6.) The contrel executive of the F 'abration is autonomous in all its activities with the exeption of those who bear legel character. In accordence with 1 the executive committee will notify in good time the executive committee of the FIAF of its resolutions and will consider its eventual suggestions for alteretions.
7.) The regional erpups nomed in 3 will engege in research work in a free mennex they will receive suggestions of themes by the central executive, as it ix also is very desirable thet they will notify the central executive of the themes they are working on in oxder to avoid double treatmento Further, in accordance with the orgenisation of the FIAF the exchence of internal infermations by way of the centrel executive is desirable.
8.) The rosearch workes nemed in 7 cen in thoir title boar the note MFRDERATIONT INTMRNATIONALE POUR LA REGHRRCHE CINBMATOGRAPHIQUE" if these works have beem submitted to the central executive beforehand (in typing) and hetve been approved of by it. The FIAF-Bulletin will present a report on the activities of the regionel groups (and corrosponding members) once a year and will, if possible, publish the works in this bulletin as well, or in special publications. It is expected to oither publish a manual bi-annualiy of 红 annually to publish an ennueire of the Fódration Internationale B.1. Reैcherche Cinématographique, Apart from distinquished works of the regingal groups (or corresponding members), this book will carry the ennual report (bi-anmual report respectively) of the FGiGration with am eccount of its struoture, its members, etc.

The contral exrocutive wobles in ilscussions of its members and regionel representatives on occasion of the yearly assembly of the FIAF as it has done up to now. However, finly the congress of the Federation Internationalo

क.1. Rècherche Cinómatographique which it to be held bi-annually is competemt to pass resolutions. At this congress to be convened for the first time in 1960 the prosont statutes $\mathbb{1} .11$ (porheps with alterations and additions) be finally docreed upoz. Here, all members of the F'́deration Internationele pol. Rêcherche Cinematographiqe (also corresponding members) as well as members of the regional groups have the right to vote. Up to this date the central exeoutive will es a Comite restraint conduct the preparatory works and will contact all regionel groups or their permenent represontatives ( 3) which have to be mede known to it. Lenguages of correspondence are french, english, russian and german as vell as the languages applied in the congress. The language of scientific works is free in accordance with the regional groups, they will be published in this language, perheps vith an ebrege in one of the four languages of congresm.
10.) In ordor to fulfill the activitios nomed in 6-9, the contral executive of the Féderation Internationale pour la, Rếcherche Cin Omatographique will impose a sum of ..... irom every central group (without regerd to the number of its members) which is due for the first time ith the be ginning of the year 1960. Corcesponding members nominated by the central exeoutive are ercmpted from this fee. However, should individual persons or associations apply for membership, thon their contributions will be fixed from time to time hy the central exeeutive and in sereement with the expoutive committee of the FIAF。
