Dear Karen,

We have pleasure in offering you a contract for the post of Editor of the International Index to Film Periodicals. The terms of employment are as follows:

- 1) Your place of work will be the F.I.A.F. office at 90/98 Shaftesbury Avenue, London W.1.
- 2) You will edit all indexing forms sent to you by the participating archives.
- You will edit the card material for the annual printed catalogue of the Index.
- 4) The contract will run from 1st May, 1974 until 30th April, 1975.

The post will be graded as the equivalent of a Grade 8 post at the British Film Institute and subject to salary increases that apply to British Film Institute staff. The salary will be £3,599 per annum and will be paid in English Pounds on the last day of each month, in equal parts, commencing May 1974.

- 5) Your hours of work will be 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Friday, with one hour for lunch.
- 6) All sundry expenses met out of petty cash must be accounted for by a statement at the end of each month.

- 7) All other expenses for the operation of the project must first be authorised by a F.I.A.F. Executive member and paid out of the F.I.A.F. account in London. Monthly accounts must be provided to the Secretariat.
- 8) All cases of sickness should be notified immediately to the Secretariat of F.I.A.F. and the National Film Archive in London.
- 9) You will be entitled to fifteen days holiday per annum on a pro-rata basis. The dates on which you would like to take your holiday should be notified to the National Film Archive and the Secretariat.
- 10) This contract may be terminated at any time at one month's notice on either side.
