An important new information service is launched in 1979 by the International Federation of Film Archives (FIAF) in association with the International Federation of Television Archives (FIAT).

The new service will follow the well-established format of the International Index to Film Periodicals (1972-) and is called the INTERNATIONAL INDEX TO TELEVISION PERIODICALS. It will consist of an annotated card service supplying information on the contents of some 48 television periodicals from 18 countries, e.g.: Broadcast (UK), Television/Radio Age (US), the European Broadcasting Union Review and Studies in Broadcasting (Japan).

The card service is sent at regular intervals to subscribers giving vital information on articles, programme reviews, interviews etc. on the world of television production and research.

No other speedy indexing service is available in this area and all television libraries, researchers and programme makers will find the INDEX invaluable. More than 30 television and film institutions from more than 20 countries are participating in preparing the information which is coordinated at the London office.

No single indexer could attempt to provide such a service, yet the INTERNATIONAL INDEX TO TELEVISION PERIODICALS will provide a fast, accurate service, ready for filing in your documentation collection - for the equivalent of about two weeks' salary of an indexer.
