Thanks for your cheerful letter and all the work you have done. We received the documents BIRHC the same day as your personal letter to me. Will try to find a calm moment in "la vie de H.L." and let him look all over them, as well as the excellent bibliography concerning Dr Gregor which you prepared. The documents you sent are very helpful and we will mail your Prague report to Milena who is doing the transcript of the minutes to help her with the names and details.

As to your question concerning the membership fees for the BIRHC, the sum is 1000 French Francs per year for each National Committee. In addition, every historian who has been named individually as a Member of the BIRHC whether or not he belongs to a National Committee is requested to pay 100 French Francs per year.

The copy of the compte rendu du BIRHC Paris was sent to you the 14th of November. Later we found your original copy among the papers of Monsieur Langlois, which we will give you if you wish when you come to Paris for the Executive Committee, and during that visit, I hope we will have some time free time together to wander through Paris and gab a bit.
