

Dear Madame Malewsky,

I am sorry that I was not in when you called this afternoon.

I am sending you a copy, both in English and in French of the draft convention for freeing educational films from customs duty. This Convention was drafted at the First General Conference of Unesco in November, 1946. It has now been sent to all governments for their comments and observations. As you will see from the covering letter which was sent to governments, we have asked for these comments and observations by June 30th. Until then it will not be possible to decide what further action will be desirable and possible. I would emphasize again that this Convention is not being sent to governments for their signature and acceptance, but only for their comments.
