The 4th FIAF Summer School will be held by the Staatliche Filmarchiv der DDR in Frankfurt (Oder) from August 12 to September 1, 1979.

The 4th summer school aims to mediate basic knowledge on all aspects of the activities of a film archive.

Lecturers: mainly leading personnel of the Staatliche Filmarchiv who had already taken part in the first and second summer schools of FIAF
